- The bereaved families of British servicemen killed in Iraq, servicemen who did not realise when they joined up how "expendable" their lives were going to be, in the politicians' eyes
- Detainees (usually detained without a fair trial) who are being *tortured*, for example at Guantanamo Bay
- Alleged victims of electromagnetic weapons testing and deployment, who contact me often, from within the UK and from worldwide
- Those who will be tricked into marrying "transgendered" spouses unawares, because the "politically correct" Gender Recognition Act denies you and everybody else the right to know the true birth gender of someone one is planning to marry
- Jewish people fleeing pogroms in Russia, and others, who might be deported to their deaths, if refused asylum, perhaps because of a harsh, European Union common policy on asylum and immigration.
